

T-Shirt Block

Cutting:

Piece	Cut Size	Fabric
A (cut 2)	1-3/4" x 4-1/2"	Focus
B (cut 2)	1-1/4" x 1-1/4"	Background
C (cut 2)	1-1/4" x 1-3/4"	Focus
D (cut 2)	1-1/4" x 1-1/2"	Background
E (cut 2)	1-1/4" x 4-1/4"	Background
F (cut 2)	1-1/2" x 3"	Background
G (cut 2)	1-1/2" x 6-1/2"	Background

Sewing (see diagram on back):

Unit 1:

1—Using the stitch & flip method, sew a piece B to the corner of a piece A. Repeat for the other piece A and B, making sure to put piece B on the opposite corner from the first set.

2—Sew the A-B units from step 1 together, making sure the B pieces are together to form the V-neck.

3—Sew a piece F to the top and bottom of the unit from Step 2. Set this Unit 1 aside.

Unit 2:

1—Sew a piece D to a piece C. Repeat for the other piece D and piece C.

2—Sew a piece E to each of the C-D units from step 1.

3—Sew a piece G to each of the C-D-E units from step 2. Make sure piece G is on opposite sides of the two units. You will have two of these Unit 2s.

Sew a Unit 2 to each side of Unit 1, making sure the sleeves are oriented correctly.

You're done! It should measure approximately 6-1/2" square. Do not trim it down—the assembly committee will do that. Remember to sign your block.

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Choose a patriotic- or beach-themed focus fabric and background of your choice to piece this awesome T-shirt.
