







Hint: To make a good Y-seam, don't stitch past the dot into the seam allowance. \*\*
It is best to stop just before touching the dot.













With pencil, draw a line diagonally across the four C squares.

Sew on drawn line. Trim off excess fabric 1/4" from seam line.

Pin another C square on the other corner; sew and trim as before.

Press seams towards F.







These units should measure 3 1/2\* square.
