

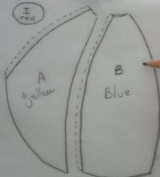
Surfside Quilters Guild is up! Which month
quilt. This month make 2 of the 'surf'




Techniques for applique may be used.

Cut: For one ball

1. Trace pattern on paper side of fusible web such as Steam-A-Seam. All patterns are reversible. Trace, cut out leaving a 1/4" margin.
2. Press to wrong side of fabric along the line.

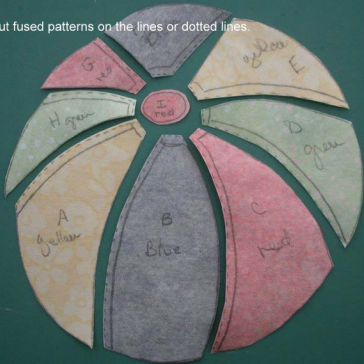


Trace pattern on paper side of fusible web that has the webbing attached to it. Write the colors on the paper if you wish.



Cut out pattern leaving a small margin around it. Remove back paper (if you are using Steam-A-Seam). Press pattern to wrong side of fabric.

Cut out fused patterns on the lines or dotted lines.





Arrange ball sections in the center of your background. Overlap one side onto the next. Because the blue shows through under the yellow, put it on top of the yellow. Check to see that the ball is round and the colors match up at the center.

Place piece "1" over the center to cover all the seams.
Press carefully.




For machine appliquing the beach ball, use invisible thread or matching thread. Test your stitching on sample pieces of fabric which have been fused to your background fabric.

Stitch around the ball close to the edge using
a straight stitch or a stitch of your choice.



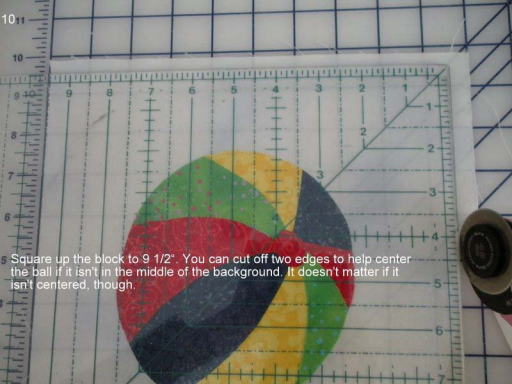
BERNINA



Stitch down each segment. Sew over the outside stitching to get from one segment to another.



Stitch around the center circle.



Square up the block to 9 1/2". You can cut off two edges to help center the ball if it isn't in the middle of the background. It doesn't matter if it isn't centered, though.

The block is finished!
