CALENDAR OF HOUSES
LET THE FABRIC DO THE WORK

BLOCK NO. 1 – JUNE - BRIDE HOUSE

Unfinished Block Size: 12 ½ x 12 ½

Fabric Needed:

Background (sky): 1 fat quarter

House: 1 fat quarter of house (cake) fabric or scraps of various fabrics

Door: fussy cut person, scene or door using scraps

Door Frame: scraps

Using Background Fabric:

Row 1 (Top): cut two strips 1 ¾ H x 5 ¾ W

Row 2 Cut two strips 1 ½H x 5 W

Row 3 Cut two strips 1 ¾H x 4 ½ W

Row 4 Cut two strips 2H x 3 ½ W

Row 5 Cut two strips 1 ½H x 3 W

Row 6 Cut two strips 1 ½H x 2 ¼ W

Row 7 Base: Cut two strips 5 ½ H x 2 W

Using House Fabric:

Row 1 Top: Cut 1 strip 1 ¾ H x 2 W

Row 2 Cut 1 strip 1 ½H x 3 ½W

Row 3 Cut 1 strip 1 ¾H x 4 ½W

Row 4 Cut 1 strip 2H x 6 ½ W

Row 5 Cut 1 strip 1 ½H x 7 ½ W

Row 6 Cut 1 strip 1 ½H x 9W

Row 7 Base: Cut two strips: 5 ½ H x 3 ½ W

Door and Door Framing

Door: Cut one strip 5 ½ H x 3 W

Door Frame: Cut two strips 1" x 5 ½ for side frames, Cut one strip 1" x 4" for top frame. Top frame is sewn on after side frames are sewn and squared up.)

Assembly

Construct as shown in photo, add desired appliqué or embellishment. Ideas: Use fabrics that represent the month, (brides, limousines, house of worship, food, drinks, lace, etc.) Add windows, pearl button for doorknob. Appliqué "frosting".
