WHAT YOU'LL NEED

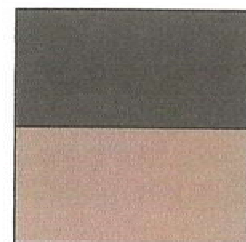
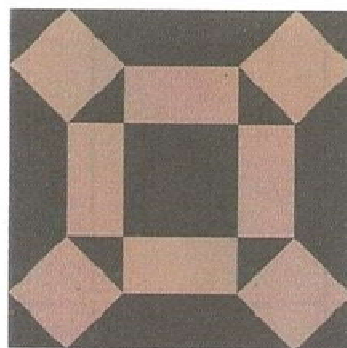
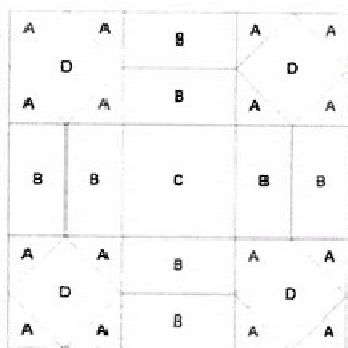
For fabric choices refer to the block diagram

A: 16 squares $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$

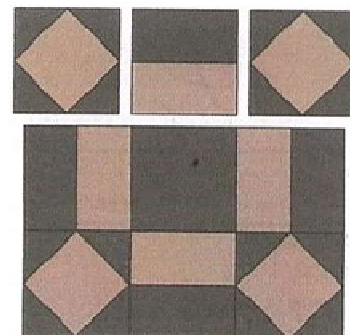
B: 8 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$

C: 1 square $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

D: 4 squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

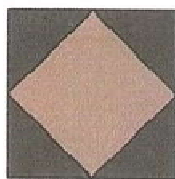


3. Arrange square-in-a-square units, strip pieced units C square into three rows as shown. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to complete the block. Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$.

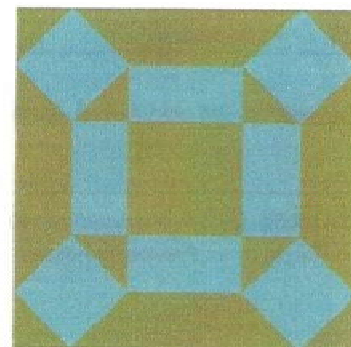


ASSEMBLY

1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS stitch and flip technique make four square-in-a-square units with the A squares and D square. The unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$.



2. Sew together a light and a dark B rectangle to make a square. Make four strip-pieced units, measuring $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$.
