

Block of the Month: Calendar of Houses
“Let The Fabric Do The Work”

OCTOBER - PUMPKIN HOUSE
Unfinished Block Size 12 ½” x 12 ½”

Materials

Sky Background: 1 fat quarter or large scrap

House: 3 fat eights

Roof peaks, windows, door: large scraps

Pumpkins: orange scraps

Ghosts: white scraps

Bats: black scraps

Fusible web

Using House Fabric

Cut 1 - 4 ½” x 9 ½” (center)

Cut 2 - 4 ½” x 7 ½” (sides)

Using Sky Background Fabric

Cut 1 - 3 ½” x 4 ½”

Cut 2 - 4 ½” x 5 ½”

Using Roof Peak Fabric

Cut 2 - 4” x 4” Cut these in half diagonally creating half square triangles.
Center and appliqué a triangle to each of the three sky backgrounds.

Referring to photo, sew each roof peak section to each house section. Press. Sew columns together.

Using Scraps

: Add seam allowance if using hand or machine appliqué method.

Door: Cut 1 - 2 ½” x 3”

Windows: Cut 6 - 2 ½” x 2 ½”

Pumpkins, Ghosts, Bats: see templates
