
Trace 8 wedge patterns onto the non-waxy side of a 3" x 18" piece of freezer paper. In this picture the wedges are joined to simplify marking and cutting. Cut a second piece of freezer paper about the same size.

Reynolds Freezer Paper 150











You will need one 10" square of background fabric. Cut out wedges leaving 1/4" around all edges.



Pin and sew wedges starting at wide edge and ending at end of paper at the narrow end. Sew close to but not on the paper. Clip threads.











Find center of background fabric by ironing creases in both directions. Pin life preserver to the square.





Square up your block to 9 1/2" and it is now complete.
