

BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Love of Triangles

General Information

1. This year Block of Month is “Love of Triangles”. All the blocks will be made up of different arrangements of triangles.
2. We will only use three different colors to make the blocks.
3. I selected Red, White and Blue for this project. You can use any colors you like. If you want to make a scrappy quilt, just add any colors you would like.
4. The triangles are 3” finished and the blocks will be 12” finished. If you want to make a mini quilt, the triangles will be 1” finished and blocks will be 4” finished. **The mini quilt yardage will be in parenthesis ().**
5. If you want to use all the same fabrics in your quilt, the yardage needed will be as follows:

Blue for blocks and sashing:	1 + 5/8 yards (1/4 yard)
Red for blocks:	3/4 yard (1/4 yard)
White for blocks:	1 + 1/2 yards (1/2 yard)
Yellow for sashing:	3/8 yard (1/8 yard)
Borders:	1 + 5/8 yards (1/4 yard)
Backing:	4 + 5/8 yards (5/8 yard)
Binding (2 1/2” strips):	7/8 yard (2 1/4” strips—3/8 yard)

6. If you would like to make all your triangles for all the blocks at once, below is the number of triangles you will need.

Unfinished Sizes

Blue and White triangles: 86 half-square triangles--4” (2”) squares.
Red and White triangles: 74 half-square triangles--4” (2”) squares.
Blue and Red triangles: 16 half-square triangles----4” (2”) squares.
Red squares: 4---3 1/2” (1 1/2”).
White squares: 8---3 1/2” (1 1/2”).

7. Make an extra block for Philanthropy or Wounded Warriors or even better yet----- donate your finished quilt.
