

BOM 2011 – 2012
CALENDAR OF HOUSES
LET THE FABRIC DO THE WORK

NOVEMBER – PILGRIM HOUSE
Unfinished Block Size 12 ½” x 12 ½”

Materials

Background: 12 ½” x 12 ½” (Cut slightly larger and square off upon completion)
House: 1 fat quarter or 2 fat quarters
Door, Door Moulding, Window(s), Hatband, Buckle, Scraps
Fusible Web

Apply fusible web before cutting shapes.

NOTE: If not using fusible web, add seam allowance for hand or machine appliqué.

Top Section of House:

Cut 1 – 8” W x 6 ½”H, fold in half **widthwise**. Measure ¾” in from top corners. With straight edge draw line from ¾” mark to outside bottom corners. Cut on this line creating top (trapezoid shape) section of house.

Bottom Section of House:

Cut 1 – 12 ½”W x 4 ½”H” fold in half **widthwise**. Measure 2 ¼” in from top corners. With straight edge draw line from 2 ¼” mark to outside bottom corners. Cut on this line creating a second trapezoid shape which is the bottom section of house.

Remaining Pieces

Door : Cut 1 – 3 x 4 ¼”. Cut additional trim moulding around door if desired.

Hat Band : 1 ¼” x 8” fold in half widthwise. Measure ¼” in from top corners. With straight edge draw line from ¼” mark to outside bottom corners. Cut on this line creating required trapezoid shape.

Buckle: Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 1 ¾”

Assemble onto background fabric per photo

Let the Fabric Do The Work: Place pilgrims, apple pie, turkey, etc on window sills, cut curtains for windows.....have fun.
